Fort Benning, Home of the MCOE

- Marion County Gate Construction Access Point
 - Projected to start soon
 - Projected to be complete NLT 30 MAR 2010
 - This gate will be for contractors only in order to build the Multi Purpose Training Range
- Approval of a New Land Navigation Site
 - Construction is currently ongoing
 - Expected to be complete NLT 01 JUN 2010
 - Located in India Training Area, on Red Diamond Road, South of SLC

Fort Benning, Home of the MCOE

- Dixie Road Widening
 - Projected Start on 01 SEP 2010
 - Projected to be complete NLT MAR 2012
 - This 4 lane road connects with 185 interchange and runs through the middle of post
 - The project currently includes a bike trail roughly from Splinter Village down to the end of main post
 - There is an option to extend the bike trail to the 185 interchange.

Fort Benning, Home of the MCOE

- 8th Division Road
 - Started on 01 MAY 2009
 - Projected to be complete NLT 31 MAY 2010
 - This 4 lane road is located at Harmony Church and will greatly improve traffic flow on post for Soldiers and Civilians
